Here's how to participate:

- Sign your completed artwork(s) **ON THE BACK**. (Shhhh... That's the "secret" part of the show: patrons will not be able to discover who their Secret Artist is until after they make a donation to acquire their chosen artwork!)
- Fill out the enclosed Artist Entry Form and email us your Artist Biography to be included in our event marketing efforts.
- Mail your work of art and the enclosed Artist Entry Form to the Foundation by **August 18, 2017** or arrange a pick-up if you are in Burbank. We appreciate your cooperation with our deadline, which gives us plenty of time to prepare each work of art for the Show. Artwork received early will be included in our launch promotion for the event!

All secrets will be revealed the night of the Secret Art Show, an annual event featuring several hundred 4x6-inch original works of art – available on a first come, first served basis for a donation of \$40 each. The festivities will also include a hosted wine and cheese reception, music, live art demonstrations, and MORE! All proceeds will benefit the Foundation's work in supporting arts education programs for the more than 15,000 students in Burbank Unified Schools.

Artist FAQs 2017

Who can submit original works of art to The Secret Art Show?

Anyone and everyone*! In the past, The Secret Art Show has featured over 1,000 pieces from professional artists, animators, celebrities, community members, students of ALL ages, dignitaries, etc...Everyone is welcome to submit!

Submissions from Minors (under the age of 18) **must have a Parent/Guardian signature on the Artist Entry Form.*

What type of art can I submit?

In preparation for The Secret Art Show, you are welcome to submit drawings, paintings, doodles, wood carvings, collages, photographs, stained glass, sculptures...the options are limitless. Here are the requirements: each piece must be an **original** work (please do not send photocopies of pieces); every piece must have an original artist signature **on the back of the work**; each piece must measure 4x6 inches.

How many pieces may I submit?

Some Artists choose to donate one piece to the Secret Art Show, while others chose to submit several individual pieces or a completed series of original work.

Do I still own the rights to my artwork(s)?

Yes. The Artist still owns the copyright to their work. By donating the work(s), the Artist gives the Foundation the right to use your artwork(s) in promotional and marketing materials for the show (i.e. the Foundation's website, social media, signage, etc.).

How long can my Artist Biography be?

Please limit Artist Biographies to a maximum of 200 words*. Be sure to include your artist website, if you have one!

The Foundation will be promoting our Secret Artists in our directory prior to the Show. Plus, our patrons want to know who you are – part of the fun is discovering each Secret Artist's identity! If you are a returning artist and would like us to use the bio on file from previous years, please indicate this on your Entry Form. **Please note that the Foundation reserves the right to edit bios for length and content.*

What is the best way to get my artwork(s) to the Foundation?

There are several ways to submit your art to The Secret Art Show:

- Drop it off at the Foundation's office (348 E. Olive Ave, Suite D, Burbank, CA 91502), Monday-Friday during regular business hours from 9am-5pm.
- Call us to arrange a pick-up (818.736.5269). Our staff is more than happy to pick up from your Burbank location!
- Mail your pieces to our office. If you choose to ship your pieces to us via USPS, FedEx, or UPS, please be sure to package it properly. To ensure the quality of your art, do not wrap the pieces in anything with printing on it – we don't want the ink to transfer to your art in the shipping process!

What happens to remaining art pieces after the Show?

The Foundation keeps all remaining artwork after the Show and the Online Auction for use to further our mission. If an artist would like their piece returned, please contact the Foundation for more information.

How do I get tickets to the Secret Art Show?

For good and valuable consideration herein acknowledged as received, the undersigned, being the legal owner of, or having the right to permit the taking and use of certain artwork described above does grant to Burbank Arts for All Foundation ("Producer"), and its legal representatives, agents, and assigns the full rights to incorporate images of said artwork on the website for the Secret Art Show. Producer shall solely own the copyright in the aforesaid show, and any advertising or promotional materials for such show. The undersigned also consents to the use of images of said artwork in any printed matter and advertising and marketing materials used to promote said show. Producer shall have all rights to use said artwork, including images of the aforementioned artwork, in all media now known or hereinafter devised, and in all territories worldwide, in perpetuity for these purposes.

The undersigned hereby waives any right that he/she/it may have to inspect or approve the Secret Art Show, or the advertising copy or printed matter that may be used in connection therewith, or the use to which it may be applied. While every attempt will be made to accommodate all artists, submission of art does not guarantee inclusion in the show.

The undersigned hereby releases, discharges, and agrees to hold Producer, its legal representatives, and assigns, and all persons acting under its permission or authority, or those for whom it is acting, from any liability by virtue of any alterations (including, but not limited to blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form), whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking of said artwork image(s) or in any subsequent processing thereof, as well as any publication thereof, even though it may subject the undersigned to ridicule, scandal, reproach, scorn, and indignity.

The undersigned hereby warrants that he/she is of full age and has every right to contract in his/her own name in the above regard or represents a minor as a parent/legal guardian. The undersigned states further that he/she has read the above authorization, release, and agreement, prior to its execution, and that he/she is fully familiar with the contents thereof. If the undersigned is signing as an agent or employee of a firm or corporation, the undersigned warrants that he/she is fully authorized to do so. This release shall be binding upon the undersigned and his/her/its heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns.
